MEDECOS conferences bring together ecologists and resource managers from all five Mediterranean-climate regions of the world. First held in 1971 in Valdivia, Chile, and then in 1977 at Stanford, California, MEDECOS conferences are now held every 3 to 4 years at locations rotating around these regions. The very successful MEDECOS XI conference was hosted by the University of Western Australia in Perth in September 2007. MEDECOS XII promises to be special since it marks the 40th anniversary of the MEDECOS conferences.
